

The Columbus VA has walk-in spaces for Covid-19 vaccines all this week, Monday thru Saturday, April 5-10, from 8:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m., and on Thursday evening from 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. Vaccines are administered at the Chalmers P. Wylie VA Ambulatory Care Clinic at 420 N. James Road.

The Thursday evening and Saturday clinics will administer the Johnson & Johnson single dose vaccine. All other clinics will administer the 2-dose Moderna vaccine. For the Moderna vaccine, Veterans receiving their first dose must be able to schedule a return appointment 28-days later to receive their second dose.

NEW: Guidance from the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) - The VA is now vaccinating all Veterans and their spouses and caregivers. This includes any person who ever served in the military – Active Duty, Reserve, or National Guard – regardless of their time in service, active duty status or character of discharge. All appointments and walk ins subject to availability of vaccines at the healthcare facility.

Registration is still required before Veterans can make an appointment or walk in. Registration can be done in one of the following ways:

- In person M – F, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the Columbus VA or a Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC). Veterans must bring a filled out Form 10-10ez, <https://www.va.gov/vaforms/medical/pdf/10-10EZ-fillable.pdf>
- Via phone at 1(877)222-VETS (8387) – veterans will receive a prompt to enroll following the introductory information
