- 3. Post, districts should be planning Memorial Day observances. Officers should see that suitable grave markers, wreaths and U.S. flags are placed on the graves of deceased veterans.
- 4. Per Section 213 of the National Bylaws, Posts that have not submitted a properly completed Post Election Report by June 1 are in arrears and shall be deprived of all representation in District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustments of such deficiencies. Posts that have registered delegates for the Department will not receive credentials until the Post has satisfied their arrearage.
- 5. Attention is directed to the provision of Section 222 (d) of the National Bylaws, "Each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials, and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a ten-dollar (\$10) delegate fee." Post Quartermasters are encouraged to register their delegate(s) online through the Online Membership System (OMS). Posts failing to comply with this provision will be considered delinquent and in arrears
- 6. Installing officers will see that the provisions of Section 217 of the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure are properly carried out and that all officers are members in good standing and qualified to hold office prior to installing Post officers for the current year. Post officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed. The installing officer shall ascertain that a Post-Election Report must be submitted to National Headquarters prior to the installation. Attention is directed to see that the proper amount of dues the Post charges is reported to National Headquarters. If a post decides to keep current officers, department recommends they do so for the complete year.
- 7. Attention of incoming Post Officers is directed to Section 218, Manual of Procedure, which outlines those duties of various Post Officers.
- 8. **Post/District Service Officer: MOP (Manual of Procedures) Section 218, (12) Service Officers:** The work of a Service Officer shall be performed in accordance with the instructions contained in the VFW Guide for Service Officers under the general supervision of the Department Service Officer.
- 9. District Elected Officers are reminded that a copy of their DD214 or other proof of eligibility must be forwarded to the VFW Department of Ohio Quartermaster/Adjutant no later than 30 days after they were elected.
